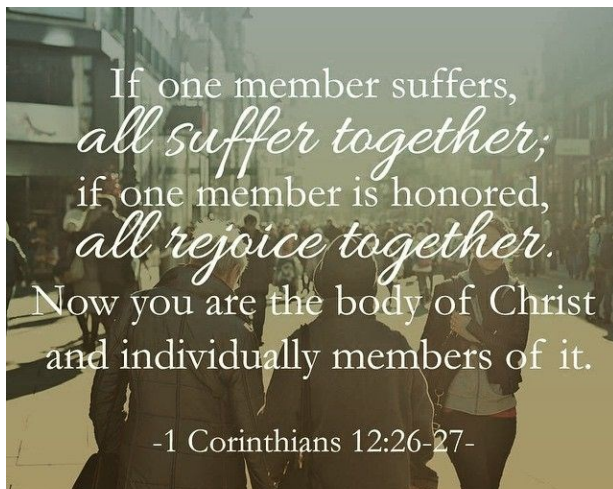
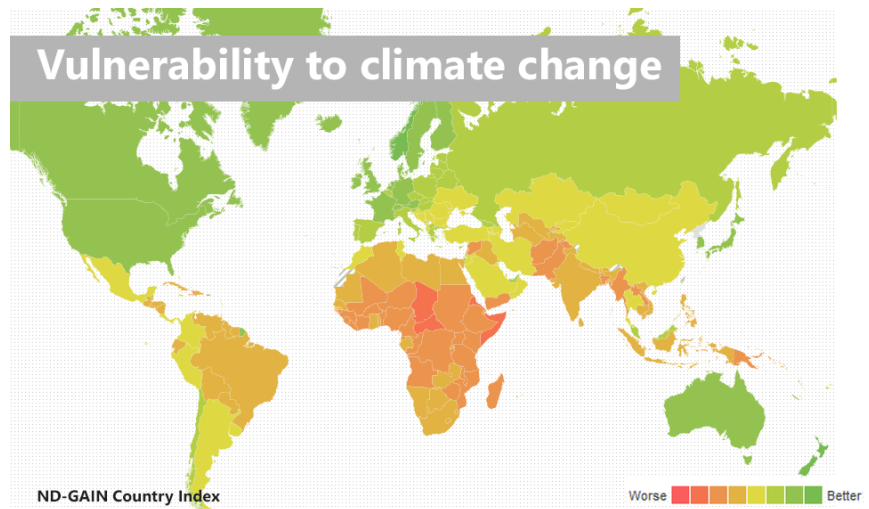
Who Suffers Most from Climate Change? Week 2

This week, we are looking at the intersection between climate change, migration and racial inequities.

The communities and nations least responsible for climate change, especially those in the southern hemisphere, are on the frontlines of its impacts. This is true on a national and international scale. From floods to droughts, extreme heat, destruction of homes and crops as well as both water and air pollution; communities of color are bearing the brunt of the climate crisis.

Climate change is also driving the displacement of entire populations who are already vulnerable and suffering.

People from some of the most fragile and conflict-affected countries are disproportionately affected by extreme weather and are having to take on dangerous journeys and migrate to survive. These same people who flee their homes often face discrimination as they seek safety in other nations.
